

The Shakujiikoen Furusato Museum has been opened on March 2010, in the place adjacent to the Shakuji Park, rich of the environment and history.

This is a new type museum where you can enjoy empirical learning about the history, the traditional culture and the environment of the Nerima Ward. Meantime the museum dispatches touristic information.

Gallery and Conference room are available with charge for exhibitions of creative works, presentations or other multiple cultural activities. (When they are used for any event sponsored by the Museum, this service is unavailable).

\* Special Exhibitions require admission fee.



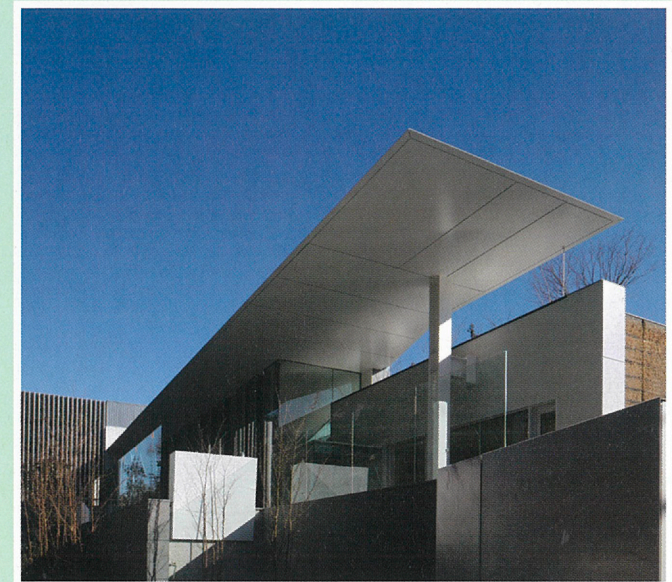
### ● Access

- ◆ Get off at "Shakuji-koen Station" of Seibu Ikebukuro Line, and 15 minutes on foot.
  - ◆ Get off at "Kamiigusa Station" of Seibu Shinjuku Line, and 20 minutes on foot.
  - ◆ Get off at "JA Tokyo Aoba" Stop of Seibu Bus, and 5 minutes on foot. (Shakuji-koen Station South-Kamiigusa Station-Ogikubo Station).
  - ◆ Get off at "JA Tokyo Aoba" Stop of Midori Bus, and 5 minutes on foot. (Root Sekimachi: Sekimachi Fukushien-Kamishakuji Station-Nerima Takanodai Station-Jyuntendou Nerima Hospital).
  - ◆ Get off at "Sanpoji Ike" Stop of Seibu Bus, and 2 minutes on foot. (Nagakubo-Oizumi-gakuen Station South-Kamiigusa Station-Ogikubo Station-Asagaya Station).

### Wagamachi Nerima information area 1

Birds, insects and plants found around the Museum, and sights to see, walking courses and traditional works of the Nerima Ward are presented.



### Rest area

Here visitors can taste “Musashino Udon” (Noodle).

### Conference room

Courses on manufacturing etc. are held here.

Courses sponsored by the Museum and others are held here.



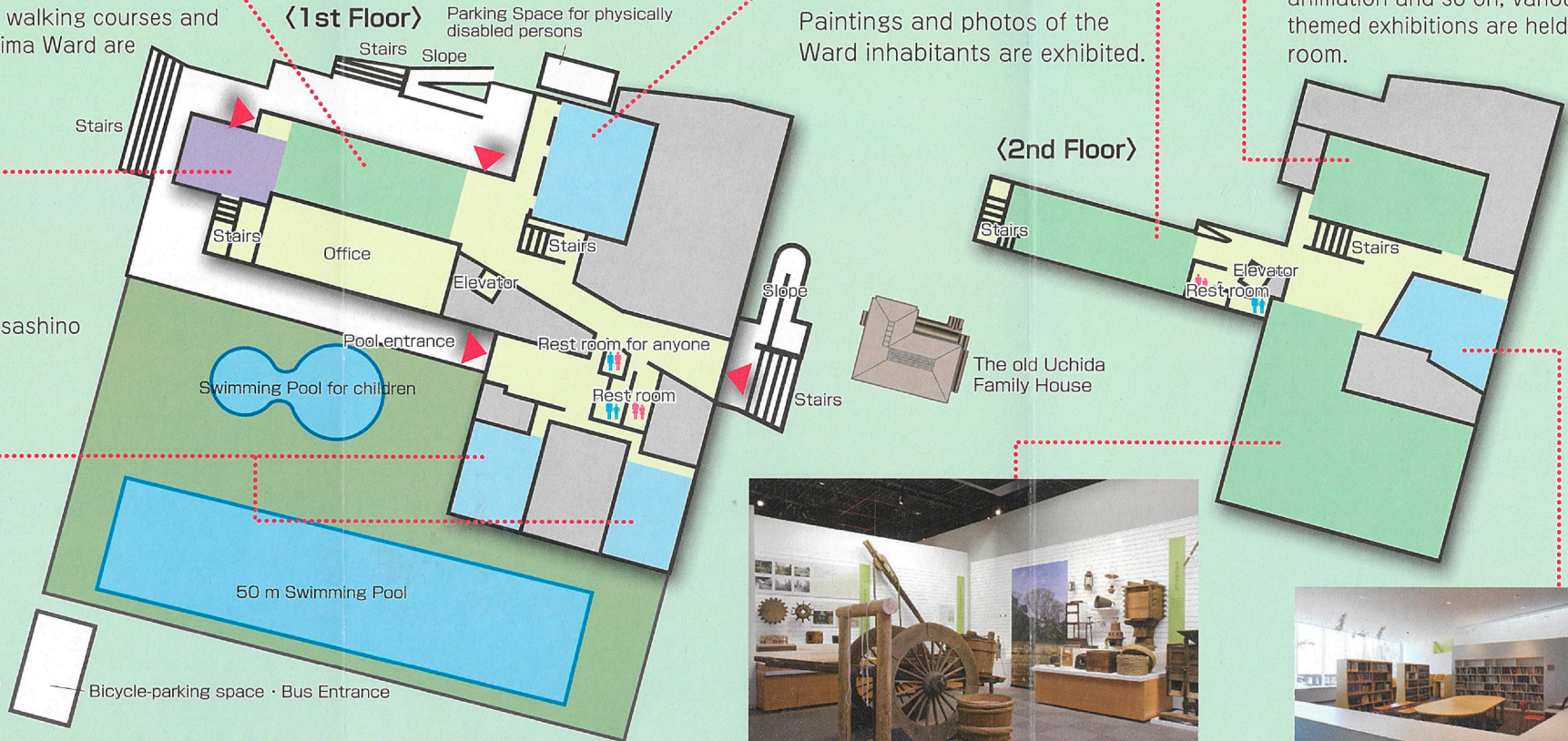
### Wagamachi Nerima information area 2

Paintings and photos of the Ward inhabitants are exhibited.



### Temporary exhibition room

Regarding the cultural property, the animation and so on, various themed exhibitions are held in the room.



### Permanent exhibition room

The unearthed articles such as earthenware, and the hardiworks, compiled information on the “Nerima Daikon” (White Radish) are exhibited, through which visitors could learn the history and the living mode of the Nerima Ward. Also the articles which the visitors can enjoy learning by touching and using are exhibited.



### Exchange library

Books on the Folkways, the History and the Environment of the Nerima Ward are collected. The visitors can read them and learn by them.

### The old Uchida Family House (Ikebuchi Historic Spot Park in Nerima City)

This is a private house with a thatched roof (The Cultural Property designated by the Nerima City) at had been dismantled in the Nerima Ward and reconstructed in Ikebuchi Historic Spot Park which is next to the Furusato Museum.

The reconstruction has been made according the early Showa era type and visitors are admitted to visit it and look on the inside.
