







Recommended route for customers using wheelchairs and baby strollers

*shortest route from the station or bus stop

■ If using the Oizumi-Gakuen Station South Exit on Seibu Bus

Route	
1	 <p>Go right after getting off the Seibu Bus at the Oizumi-Gakuen Station South Exit stop.</p>
2	 <p>Follow the rotary toward the station.</p>
3	 <p>There is an elevator lobby on the left. * This is in front of the escalator heading to the floor for the Oizumi Gakuen Station (Seibu Ikebukuro Line) gates, to the rear of the postbox.</p>
4	 <p>Take the elevator to the second floor.</p>
5	 <p>From the elevator go right, following a path shaped like this: ㄣ.</p>
6	 <p>You will see the Yumeria 1 building(“ゆめりあ1”) in which the Yumeria Hall is located at the far left. Go straight over the railway.</p>






7	 <p>At the fork go diagonally left.</p>
8	 <p>Go down the slope toward the second floor entrance to the Yumeria 1 building in which the Yumeria Hall is located.</p>
9	 <p>There is an elevator lobby on the left of the entrance.</p>
10	 <p>Use the elevator to travel to each floor. Fifth floor = Yumeria Hall office (reception) Sixth floor = Yumeria Hall entrance Seventh floor = Yumeria Gallery</p> <p>* The sixth and seventh floors are accessible according to event times. If the elevator does not stop at these floors, go to the office (reception) on the fifth floor.</p>
